The stained-glass windows below are the central group of a set of 9 windows in the Air Force Chapel in the National Basilica of the Sacred Heart, Koekelberg, Brussels. They were created as a result of a RAFA Belgian Branch sponsored fund-raising initiative and were dedicated in the presence of the King of the Belgians on 21 September 1988.



The windows, and the Air Force Chapel in which they are installed, commemorate those Belgians who in the Second World War fought with the Royal Air Force as well as those who acted as intelligence agents in Belgium, together with the civilians of the Belgian escape lines who risked their lives to save so many downed airmen.
